Stock will not be accepted before designated times and exhibitors should have their stock in place by the designated times. Please see the Show Secretary before putting stock in spaces.

All stock must remain in assigned spaces during designated times unless special arrangements are made with the Show Secretary at the time the stock is placed is spaces.

All stock must be checked in and checked out by the Show Superintendent. All stock must be permanently and legibly ear marked before arrival at the show.

Each rabbit must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.

No substitutions are allowed except in the same breed, sex, color, and class.

Absolutely no breeding of stock on the fairgrounds.

Senior judging will be performed by an A.R.B.A. judge or judges.

No breeds sanctioned the following year unless 10 or more are shown the previous year.

No feed furnished. All local exhibitors are asked to feed and care for their own stock. Out of town exhibitors are to make arrangements for feeding stock with the Show Secretary and Show Superintendent at the time the rabbits are caged. All cages must be cleaned under the prior to removal of animals. Premiums will be held until cleaned.

The Senior Fair Rabbit Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that is not deemed for the best interest of the show.

The Clinton County Agricultural Society and committees are not responsible for loss or damage of stock; however, precaution will be taken to eliminate damages and mistakes in the showroom. A competent watchman will be provided day and night.

Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years

The youth division is governed by the same rules as the senior division, as set by the A.R.B.A.

Any rule violation will result in elimination of the animal from the competition.
