Division 3: Baked Goods

Rules and Guidelines:

No commercial mix.

No store-bought items, must be homemade.

Pan or container size does not count towards judging.

Tea towel, napkin, or breadbasket not required.

Glassware is not recommended. Committee not responsible for breakage or loss.

Decorated cakes/cupcakes – may use dummy form, will not be cut.

Cookies – 3 cookies on a 6" foam, paper, or plastic plate.

Breads – plate only, no basket or container.

Candy – 3 pieces on a 6" foam, paper, or plastic plate.

Miscellaneous items – use plastic bag.

Baked Goods Auction:

All first and second place baked goods entries are required to be donated to the Baked Goods Auction. Bakers who donate their baked good to be auctioned will receive 50% of the sale proceeds of their baked goods.

The auction will consist of cakes (non-decorated classes), cookies, yeast breads, quick breads, and pie division entries.

Cupcakes, cookies, and brownies – minimum of 12 on a disposable plate, covered, or plastic container. Rolls, biscuits, and muffins – minimum of 6 on a disposable plate, covered, or plastic container.
