Entry fee of \$2.00 will be charged per entry.

Exhibitor is required to purchase a season pass or membership ticket to enter.

Exhibitor may enter as many classes as they would like, but only one entry per class.

Entry must have entry tag completed and attached to item at drop off.

General Information:

NO early release of exhibits.

Judging will be open and questions may be asked at the end of the judging session based on the judge's availability.

The judge may withhold the premium of the entry if not worthy of an award.

All judging is not final until one hour after all items have been judged.

The Clinton County Agricultural Society and committees are not responsible for loss or damage, nor responsible for items not picked up by release time.

Frame does not count on size.

All pictures must have wire, bracket, etc.

Plastic canvas only acceptable in Section 7.

No pedestals.

### **Division 3: Baked Goods**

#### **Rules and Guidelines:**

No commercial mix.

No store-bought items, must be homemade.

Pan or container size does not count towards judging.

Tea towel, napkin, or breadbasket not required.

Glassware is not recommended. Committee not responsible for breakage or loss.

Decorated cakes/cupcakes – may use dummy form, will not be cut.

Cookies – 3 cookies on a 6" foam, paper, or plastic plate.

Breads – plate only, no basket or container.

Candy – 3 pieces on a 6" foam, paper, or plastic plate.

Miscellaneous items – use plastic bag.

Judging: Tuesday, July 11 at 10:00am

Baked Goods Auction: Tuesday, July 11 at 5:30pm

Release: Tuesday, July 11 one hour after judging has been completed

#### **Baked Goods Auction:**

All first and second place baked goods entries are required to be donated to the Baked Goods Auction. Bakers who donate their baked good to be auctioned will receive 50% of the sale proceeds of their baked goods.

The auction will consist of cakes (non-decorated classes), cookies, yeast breads, quick breads, and pie division entries.

Cupcakes, cookies, and brownies – minimum of 12 on a disposable plate, covered, or plastic container.

Rolls, biscuits, and muffins – minimum of 6 on a disposable plate, covered, or plastic container.
